ECO448 Natural Resource and Environmental Economics Assignment

<u>Select one of the two options</u> for this assignment. You will make a presentation on <u>May 15th</u> during the class and submit a report of your work on the same day.

* If you cannot attend the class on May 15th, consult the instructor as soon as possible.

Option A: Prepare 20 minutes lecture on Climate Change for elementary school students

Goal: Prepare a lecture on what "Climate Change" is and what the impacts of Climate Change on our lives could be to elementary school students (around 6^{th} grades) by using pictures, examples and easy words.

Possible contents of your lecture:

- a. What is "Climate Change"?
- b. Why is it happening?
- c. What could be the possible impacts to the earth?
- d. What could be the possible impacts to our daily lives?
- e. Other materials you want to convey to the students

Presentation:

- Language: English
- Use power point presentation (if any of you have a problem accessing the program, consult the instructor) and other materials to convey your points.
- Time of your lecture is 20 minutes.
- Imagine that your audience is 12-year-old elementary school students.
- Make sure to include "sources" of data, figures and other materials.
- Be interactive with audience so that your students will not get bored.

Report:

- Printout of your power point presentation [Print as "handouts" and place 6 slides per page]
- 1 or 2 pages, single-space report describing the following points:
 - What kind of things did you pay attention / were you careful about when you were preparing for the lecture?
 - o What were the difficulties you had encountered?
 - o What did you learn by preparing the lecture?
 - Other points you would like to bring up.

Option B: Conduct a survey on "Public Perception of Environmental Pollution in Turkey" and report the result in 20 minutes presentation.

Goal: To reveal the people's perceptions and opinions about environmental pollution problems in Turkey.

Possible contents of your survey:

- a. What kind of environmental problems have you heard of?
- b. Do you observe any kind of environmental pollution problems in Turkey? If you do, give me some examples.
- c. Have you ever experienced the health damages from such environmental pollution yourself? If you have, describe the symptoms. How about your family members, close friends...?
- d. Are you taking any pre-cautious measures to reduce the impact of environmental pollutions?
- e. Do you know any policy implemented to prevent / reduce environmental pollution?
- f. What kind of measures/policies do you think we need to reduce the problem?
- g. Other demographic information (age, occupation etc...) which help your analysis

Be creative and include more interesting questions of your own!!!

Survey implementation:

- Collect at least 20 samples.
- Survey can be in Turkish

Presentation:

- Language : English
- Use power point presentation (if any of you have a problem accessing the program, consult the instructor) and other materials to convey your points.
- Time of your lecture is 20 minutes.
- Present your survey questions (translate them into English) and report the results and analysis. Do not simply list the answers. The analysis could include regression model estimation and/or other measures.

Report:

- Printout of your power point presentation [Print as "handouts" and place 6 slides per page]
- Filled-out surveys
- 1 or 2 pages, single-space report describing the following points:
 - o Analysis of your results
 - o Unexpected results, expected results
 - o If you are the policy advocator for the reduction of environmental pollution, how do you approach the public given the results of your survey?
 - o Other points you would like to discuss.
